**JOINT MOTION FOR EXTENSION OF TIME**

The Mechanical Licensing Collective (“the MLC”) and the Digital Licensee Coordinator (“the DLC”) (collectively, the “Participants”), hereby request an extension of time to submit proposed regulatory language and address the issues identified by the Copyright Royalty Judges (the “Judges”) in their order of November 20, 2019 (“Order”).

On November 14, 2019, the Participants filed with the Judges a Joint Notice of Settlement and Motion to Suspend Case Schedule, and asking for direction on the submission of joint proposed regulatory language implementing the Settlement. On November 14, 2019, the Judges issued an order directing the Participants to jointly file proposed regulations implementing the terms of the Settlement by November 26, 2019. On November 20, 2019, the Judges issued the Order, identifying two elements of the proposed settlement that “may be inconsistent with applicable statutory provisions.” The Order directs the Participants to address in their submission due on November 26, 2019 how the proposed regulatory terms in the settlement, including those identified in the Order, are consistent with the applicable statutory provisions of Title 17, and to

amend any inconsistent proposed terms to make them consistent with the applicable statutory provisions.

The Participants respectfully request a modest 10-day extension of their time to submit proposed regulatory language implementing the Settlement and to address the issues identified by the Judges, until December 6, 2019, so that we may have sufficient time to prepare a response that would be most helpful to the Judges.
