ORDER DENYING POWELL SECOND MOTION FOR RECONSIDERATION

On October 28, 2019, Mr. David Powell, a pro se participant in the instant proceeding, filed with the Copyright Royalty Judges (Judges) a document captioned “MOTION REPLY TO JUDGES Order 10-22-19 To Cure Defects For Reconsideration And 5% Relief Royalty Satellite Distribution Exigent (2014-2017)” ([Motion](#)). The remaining participants in this proceeding filed a joint response in opposition ([Joint Opposition](#)) on November 12, 2019. Mr. Powell did not file a reply.

Mr. Powell’s Motion on its face seeks reconsideration of the Judges’ October 22, 2019 Order denying Mr. Powell’s earlier motion for reconsideration. *See Order Denying Powell Motion for Reconsideration* (Oct. 22, 2019) ([October 22 Order](#)). The Judges do not recognize a motion for reconsideration of a denial of a motion for reconsideration to be an appropriate request for relief. The Judges will treat the Motion as a second request to reconsider the Judges’ underlying order denying Mr. Powell’s request to be added to a repayment agreement. *See Order Denying Powell Motion to be Added to Repayment Agreement* (Sep. 19, 2019) ([September 19 Order](#)). The Motion presents no new evidence or legally cognizable arguments that could form the basis for reconsideration.

The Judges, therefore, **DENY** the Motion for the reasons articulated in the *October 22 Order*.
