ORDER ENLARGING TIME FOR REPLY

On January 10, 2020, counsel for IPG attempted to electronically file in eCRB its response in opposition to the SDC's Motion for Order to Show Cause Why Multigroup Claimants Should Not Be Disqualified as an Agent to Receive Funds on Behalf of Claimants (Dec. 26, 2019) ([Motion](#)). Having encountered technical difficulties with the filing, he promptly alerted the CRB via email and attached the filing to the email.

The Judges consider the response in opposition ([Opposition](#)) to have been timely filed on January 10. 37 C.F.R. 303.5(m) (1)-(2).

On January 13, 2020, CRB staff uploaded the document to eCRB, assigning it a filing date of January 10 and serving it electronically via eCRB to the other participants.

Because of the delay in service to the other participants, and pursuant to 37 C.F.R. 303.5(m)(3), the Judges hereby **ENLARGE** the time for the SDC to reply to the Motion. The new deadline is January 21, 2020.
