**ORDER FOR ACCELERATED BRIEFING**

On February 6, 2020, the MPA-Represented Program Suppliers (MPA) filed with the Copyright Royalty Judges (Judges) its Motion to Lift Stay of Final Distribution Order ([Motion](#)). MPA asks the Judges to lift their January 16, 2020 stay ([Stay](#)) on their *Order Granting MPA's Motion for Final Distribution of 2010-13 Satellite Royalty Funds* (Jan. 13, 2020) ([Distribution Order](#)). The Judges issued the *Stay* in response to Multigroup Claimants' filing of its Petition for Panel Rehearing and/or Petition for En Banc Review (Rehearing Petition) with the U.S. Court of Appeals for the District of Columbia Circuit (DC Circuit). According to the Motion, the DC Circuit denied the Rehearing Petition on February 5, 2020.

Having found good cause to accelerate the briefing schedule on the Motion, based on: (1) the status of another ongoing proceeding subject to a statutory deadline; (2) the Judges' authority under 17 U.S.C. § 801(c) allowing them to make necessary procedural rulings, which include orders necessary to manage their calendars and dockets; and (3) the benefit of expediting the distribution of royalties to copyright owners in this proceeding, the Judges hereby **ORDER** Multigroup Claimants to file its response to the Motion, if any, by **5:00 pm (EST) on February 11, 2020**. The Judges further **ORDER** MPA to file its reply, if any, by **5:00 pm (EST) on February 14, 2020**.
