**ORDER GRANTING SIRIUS XM RADIO INC.’S AND PANDORA MEDIA, LLC’S
UNOPPOSED MOTION TO SUBMIT THE CORRECTED WRITTEN DIRECT
TESTIMONY OF DOMINIQUE M. HANSSENS**

On February 7, 2020, the Copyright Royalty Judges (Judges) received Sirius XM Radio Inc.’s and Pandora Media, LLC’s Unopposed Motion to Submit the Corrected Written Direct Testimony of Dominique M. Hanssens (Motion). Specifically, the Movants seek leave to file corrected written direct testimony (WDT) for the purpose of (a) correcting minor errors in the reported number of respondents, margin of error calculations, and chi-squared analysis; and (b) making non-substantive edits to Appendices 4 and 10 of the Hanssens WDT. In light of the Movants’ representations that the proposed corrections are non-substantive and the other participants in this proceeding have consented to the submission of the Corrected Testimony, the Judges find that good cause exists to grant the Motion.

Therefore, the Judges hereby **GRANT** the Motion.
