**ORDER GRANTING SDC THE OPPORTUNITY TO RESPOND  
TO IPG's ASSERTION OF CONFIDENTIALITY**

On May 1, 2020, the Copyright Royalty Judges (Judges) issued their *Order Directing Parties to Review Calculations of Apportionment of Accrued Interest (Order)*. The Judges issued the *Order* as a restricted document and instructed the participants to file a notice no later than May 4, 2020, identifying any material they propose to be redacted from a public version of the document.

Worldwide Subsidy Group LLC d/b/a Independent Producers Group (IPG) filed a timely [notice](#) requesting that the Judges redact any instances of the specific percentage division of royalties between IPG and the Settling Devotional Claimants (SDC) in the Devotional category, asserting that those percentages are confidential.

The *Order* made no provision for the filing of responses and replies to the requested notices concerning redactions. Nevertheless, the Judges find it appropriate to afford the SDC an opportunity to respond to IPG's assertion of confidentiality in the percentage division of Devotional Royalties. The SDC may file a response no later than Friday, May 8, 2020. IPG may file a reply no later than Wednesday, May 13, 2020.
