**ORDER TO FILE JOINT STIPULATION REGARDING  
PRIOR DISTRIBUTION OF DEVOTIONAL CATEGORY FUNDS TO IPG**

To assist the Licensing Division of the Copyright Office in calculating the proper allocation of remaining royalty funds and accrued interest in preparation for a final distribution to claimants in the Devotional Category, the Copyright Royalty Judges (Judges) need know whether any funds distributed by the common agent pursuant to partial distribution orders the Judges issued for each of the royalty years covered by this proceeding were distributed to Worldwide Subsidy Group LLC d/b/a Independent Producers Group or any claimants that it represented (IPG).<sup>1</sup> Therefore, the Judges **ORDER** the Settling Devotional Claimants (SDC) and Multigroup Claimants (MGC), the only remaining parties in the Devotional Category, to provide a joint stipulation that affirms that (1) IPG did not receive any funds pursuant to the partial distribution orders the Judges issued in this proceeding or (2) IPG received funds pursuant to one or more of the partial distribution orders. If IPG received any such funds, the joint stipulation shall set forth the amount(s) IPG received, the applicable royalty year(s), and the date of the partial distribution order(s) pursuant to which IPG received such funds.

If SDC and MGC cannot so stipulate, then the parties shall each file a separate statement that includes an explanation of why the parties could not stipulate as directed. Such stipulation or statements must be filed in eCRB no later than May 15, 2020.
