**ORDER GRANTING SERVICES’ UNOPPOSED MOTION
FOR LEAVE TO FILE CORRECTED PUBLIC VERSION
OF PROPOSED FINDINGS OF FACT AND CONCLUSIONS OF LAW**

On October 12, 2020, the Copyright Royalty Judges (Judges) received a Motion from Sirius XM Radio Inc. (Sirius XM), Pandora Media, LLC (Pandora), Google LLC (Google), the National Association of Broadcasters (NAB), and the National Religious Broadcasters Noncommercial Music License Committee (NRBNMLC) (collectively, the Services) requesting leave to submit the Corrected Public Version of their Joint Proposed Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law (Corrected Public Version). The Services represent that SoundExchange consents to the Motion. Services’ Joint Unopposed Motion for Leave to File Corrected Public Version of Proposed Findings of Fact and Conclusion of Law ([Motion](#)) at 1.

The Services state that the Corrected Public Version, which is attached as Exhibit A to the Motion, includes several additional redactions that were inadvertently omitted from the original public version submitted via eCRB on October 9, 2020. The Services state that these corrections are in furtherance of the Protective Order dated June 24, 2019. *Id.*

The Judges find that accepting the Corrected Public Version is consistent with the Protective Order entered in this proceeding and therefore the Services’ Unopposed Joint Motion is **GRANTED**.

The previously-submitted public version of the Services’ Joint Proposed Findings of Fact and Conclusions of Law that that was submitted timely and that remains pending in eCRB will be rejected by CRB staff, and the Services must file the Corrected Public Version that is attached as Exhibit A to the Motion **no later than three days from the date of this order**.
