# [PROPOSED] FINAL DISTRIBUTION DETERMINATION IN DEVOTIONAL CATEGORY

This matter is before the Judges on the motion by Multigroup Claimants for entry of a consent order adopting the shares proposed by the Settling Devotional Claimants ("SDC") in the Devotional category.

The Judges find based on the notice of Multigroup Claimants that there is no genuine dispute as to adoption of the SDC's proposed shares, and that good cause exists for entry of a final distribution determination. It is hereby
