

ORDER SUSPENDING PROCEEDING SCHEDULE

On July 2, 2018, the Participating Parties¹ filed with the Copyright Royalty Judges (Judges) a joint motion in the captioned proceeding announcing that they had agreed to a modified Sports Surcharge rule and seeking: (1) suspension of the proceeding schedule set forth in the Judges' January 12, 2018 Order Reinstating Case Schedule; (2) adoption of the agreed-upon modified Sports Surcharge rule; and (3) termination of the captioned proceeding. In their joint motion, the Participating Parties advised the Judges that they have informed Major League Soccer (MLS) of the revised proposed Sports Surcharge, and that MLS has authorized the Participating Parties to state that MLS has no objection to its adoption.

Pending review of the Participating Parties' modified Sports Surcharge rule by the Judges and publication for public comment, the Judges hereby **SUSPEND** the proceeding schedule established by the January 12, 2018 Order Reinstating Case Schedule. The Judges will defer decision on the adoption of the modified Sports Surcharge rule and termination of the proceeding until after they consider comments, if any, filed in response to the publication of the modified proposed rule.
