3 CHAIRMAN RAY: Today we start the Phase II
4 direct case for NAB. Before we started on Thursday, the
5 6th, the Tribunal granted NAB's Motion for Reconsideration
6 of MPAA's Motion to "Dismiss Claims".

7 I will read the Tribunal's decision into the
8 record. "The Motion to Dismiss Claims filed MPAA is granted,
9 in part, and denied in part. It is granted for WDBJ,
10 WTAJ, and for WCVB. It is denied for KNXT, and the
11 Tribunal directs both MPAA and NAB to furnish for the record
12 a written agreement, or signed statement with broadcast
13 station KNXT showing that they were intended to be repre-
14 sented for all syndicated programs."

15 Mr. Stewart, do you have any opening remarks for
16 us?

17 MR. LANE: I just have one preliminary matter.
18 On Friday, Mr. Lutzker asked that we supply to the record
19 a copy of the opinion in Janus Films versus Cable Films
20 and Herbert Miller. And I would like to have this marked
21 as Program Suppliers' Exhibit, I guess, just 7, since it
22 really was not cross.
