Dear Ms. Manthey Allen:



The Office of the Copyright General Counsel rejects your claim to the 1994 DART royalties for failure to file a complete claim in a timely manner. You may, of course, file a claim for DART royalties in future years.

Claims are rejected for two basic reasons: 1) either they are not received by the Register of Copyright in the months of January or February, or lack a U.S. postmark for those months on a properly addressed envelope; or 2) they lack the requisite elements to establish a claim. Occasionally, new claimants misunderstand just what facts must be included in their claim. So, in the interest of fairness, this Office will grant a new claimant an opportunity to amend their claim in a timely manner.

Your claim bore a timely U.S. postmark but lacked the requisite elements for a properly filed claim. The CARP Specialist contacted you on March 10, 1995, and explained the deficiencies noted in your claim. At that time, a DART royalty factsheet was faxed to you along with instructions to file an amended claim by March 24, 1995. On Monday, March 13, 1995, this Office sent you a follow up letter which again noted the specific deficiencies in your claim and clearly stated that an amended claim must be filed by March 24, 1995; otherwise, the claim would be dismissed for non-compliance with the filing regulations.
