This letter is submitted on behalf of SESAC, Inc. in response to your facsimile of November 21, 1996 to interested parties.

Please be advised that although it was not included in the prior communications to and from the Copyright Office in this docket, SESAC is an active licensor of performing rights to noncommercial educational broadcasters and has been a participant in previous Copyright Office compulsory license proceedings with respect to noncommercial educational broadcasting. SESAC intends to fully participate in any further proceedings herein and will be filing its formal notice of intent to participate by or before the December 13 deadline.

Accordingly, SESAC requests that it be included in any meetings that may be scheduled with the Office to discuss substantive or procedural issues in this proceeding. In that regard, we have reviewed the submissions of PBS (and certain others) dated November 1, 1996 and of ASCAP (and certain others) dated December 9, 1996, and believe those two documents adequately suggest the range of issues that ought to be placed on the agenda at any meeting that may be scheduled.
