ORDER ESTABLISHING MODIFIED REMAND SCHEDULE


On January 14, 2016, the Copyright Royalty Judges (Judges) issued an Order for Proceedings on Remand and Scheduling Order (the Scheduling Order), which required the parties to jointly file a Proposed Order establishing a detailed discovery schedule by April 20, 2016. Pursuant to the Scheduling Order, the Settling Devotional Claimants (SDC) and Independent Producers Group (IPG) (together, the Remand Participants) submitted a timely Proposed Order establishing a schedule of discovery and other concomitant deadlines in these remand proceedings. The Remand Participants propose, *inter alia*, a schedule that extends by one week the deadlines set by the Judges in the Scheduling Order.

Accepting the agreement of the Remand Participants, the Judges hereby modify the schedule originally described in Exhibit A to the Scheduling Order, to conform to the schedule attached as "Exhibit A" to this order. This modified schedule adopts most of the schedule modifications proposed by the Remand Participants.

The Judges note that the parties added a period of discovery relating to the Amended Written Direct Statements. The Judges' Scheduling Order designated a period for rebuttal discovery *before* the parties were required to file their Written Rebuttal Statements (WRS).

Regardless of the nomenclature, therefore, the Judges retain the period of discovery before the filing of WRS.
