**ORDER GRANTING PARTICIPANTS' JOINT MOTION FOR EXTENSION**

On November 14, 2019, the Participants filed with the Copyright Royalty Judges (Judges) a Joint Notice of Settlement and Motion to Suspend Case Schedule, and asked for direction on the submission of joint proposed regulatory language implementing the Settlement. On November 20, 2019, the Judges issued an order directing the Participants to address in their submission, due on November 26, 2019, how the proposed regulatory terms in the settlement, including two specifically identified in the order, are consistent with the applicable statutory provisions of Title 17, and to amend any inconsistent proposed terms to make them consistent with the applicable statutory provisions. The Participants have requested an extension of their time to submit proposed regulatory language implementing the Settlement and to address the issues identified by the Judges until December 6, 2019.

Having considered the Motion and associated scheduling concerns, the Judges hereby **GRANT** the Motion in part and **ORDER** that the Participants have until December 4, 2019 to file their submission.
