**ORDER DIRECTING PARTIES TO REVIEW CALCULATIONS OF
APPORTIONMENT OF ACCRUED INTEREST**
[Public Version]

On January 9, 2020, the Copyright Royalty Judges (Judges) issued an *Order Granting SDC Motion for Final Distribution* (*Distribution Order*) in which they stated

[T]he Judges, having found “that the distribution of ... fees is not subject to controversy,” hereby authorize the distribution of those royalty fees to the SDC and IPG in amounts to be calculated by the Licensing Division allocating interest as if the agreed distribution allocation of 68.75% to the SDC and 31.25% to IPG had been applied to each year’s fund from the date funds were deposited until the date any portion of those funds was disbursed (or from which Copyright Office expenses were deducted), with interest ceasing to accrue on funds when they were disbursed.

The Licensing Division carried out the requisite calculations as directed by the Judges consistent with the Distribution Order and provided them to the Judges. The calculations are attached as Appendix A.

The Judges hereby **DIRECT** the participants to review the calculations on Appendix A and file a notice with the Judges **no later than May 8, 2020**, stating whether or not they believe any clarifications to the calculations are necessary and, if so, an explanation of all proposed clarifications.

Although the Judges do not consider any of the content of this Order to be Protected Materials as defined in the *Protective Order* dated July 10, 2012, the Judges are issuing this Order as a restricted document out of an abundance of caution. The Judges hereby **DIRECT** the participants to file a notice **no later than May 4, 2020**, identifying any material they propose to be redacted from a public version of this Order, together with their justification for any proposed redactions.
