**ORDER GRANTING EUGENE CURRY LEAVE TO
FILE WRITTEN DIRECT STATEMENT AFTER DEADLINE**

On June 9, 2020, Eugene Curry, a pro se participant in the captioned matter, filed a Motion for Leave to File Written Direct Statement Request for Extension of Time to File ([Motion](#)). Mr. Curry states in the Motion that he missed the deadline¹ for filing his written direct statement (WDS) due to the COVID-19 pandemic and resultant loss of his livelihood as a musician. Mr. Curry requests leave to file his WDS late. The motion was unopposed.

The Judges find that Mr. Curry has shown good cause for the Judges to grant the leave he requests and that no prejudice to the other participant that has already filed its WDS exists.

The Motion is **GRANTED**. Mr. Curry is permitted to file his WDS no later than two weeks from the date of this order.
