**ORDER GRANTING JOINT MOTION TO POSTPONE SUBMISSION
OF WRITTEN DIRECT STATEMENTS**

On September 9, 2021, the Corporation for Public Broadcasting, National Public Radio, Inc., the Public Broadcasting Service, American Society of Composers, Authors and Publishers, Broadcast Music, Inc., SESAC Performing Rights, LLC, Global Music Rights, LLC, and The Harry Fox Agency LLC filed a [joint motion](#) requesting that the Copyright Royalty Judges (Judges) enter an order postponing the submission of written direct statements in this proceeding until October 11, 2021. The moving parties stated that they have reached separate agreements in principle (except as to one licensor, with whom settlement proposals have been exchanged and fruitful settlement discussions are ongoing), and are scheduling follow-up discussions to the extent necessary to execute their contemplated settlement agreements.

The Judges find that good cause exists to grant this relief. The Judges **ORDER** that the submission of written direct statements be postponed until October 11, 2021, and they direct the participants to file notices of settlement or written direct statements on or before that date. In all other respects the case schedule attached as Exhibit A to the February 9, 2021 [Notice of Participants, Commencement of Voluntary Negotiation Period, and Case Scheduling Order](#) remains in effect.
