**ORDER GRANTING JOINT MOTION REGARDING
PUBLIC VERSIONS OF WRITTEN DIRECT STATEMENTS**

On September 24, 2021, the National Music Publishers' Association and the Nashville Songwriters Associations International (collectively, Copyright Owners), together with Amazon.com Services LLC, Apple Inc., Google LLC, Pandora Media, LLC and Spotify USA Inc. (collectively, the Services) and George Johnson, filed a joint motion requesting a one-week extension of the time for the submission of public, redacted versions of written direct statements ([Motion](#)).

The Judges find good cause to grant the requested relief and therefore **GRANT** the Motion. Any participant that has filed a written direct statement that contains restricted information must file a redacted public version of its written direct statement on or before October 20, 2021. If in such participant's written direct statement a document that does not contain restricted information is bound together in the same volume as one or more documents that contain restricted information, the participant need only file that volume and those documents as a restricted filing in eCRB on October 13, 2021, and may file the public version of that volume and its documents in eCRB, with redactions applied, on or before October 20, 2021.

Any participant filing a written direct statement that does not contain any restricted information must file its written direct statement, in public form, on or before October 13, 2021.
