**ORDER GRANTING MOTION ON FURTHER BRIEFING REGARDING LIMITED  
MODIFICATION TO THE PROTECTIVE ORDER**

On September 30, 2021, Amazon.com Services, LLC, Google, LLC, Pandora Media, LLC, and Spotify USA, Inc. (collectively, the Services) submitted a Motion to Submit Sur-Reply ([Sur-reply Motion](#)) seeking the Copyright Royalty Judges' (Judges) acceptance of the Services' sur-reply (Sur-reply Motion, Exhibit A) in further opposition to a September 15, 2021 Motion by Broadcast Music, Inc. for a Limited Modification to the Protective Order in the Phonorecords IV Proceeding ([BMI Motion](#)).

The Judges, finding that further briefing on matters relating to the BMI Motion would assist them in resolving those matters, hereby **GRANT** the Services' Sur-reply Motion. The Services may submit their sur-reply by no later than October 8, 2021. The Judges further **ORDER** that responses to the sur-reply, if any, be submitted no later than October 18, 2021. The sur-reply and any responses must not exceed 5 pages and must not exceed 1500 words (exclusive of cover pages, tables of contents, tables of authorities, signature blocks, exhibits, and proof of delivery).
