NATIONAL PUBLIC RADIO, INC.’S NOTICE IN RESPONSE TO ORDER FOR FURTHER PROCEEDINGS AND SCHEDULING CASE EVENTS

National Public Radio, Inc. (“NPR”) submits this Notice pursuant to the *Order for Further Proceedings and Scheduling Case Events* (“Order for Further Proceedings”) entered by the Copyright Royalty Judges (the “Judges”) on January 10, 2022.

In the Order for Further Proceedings, the Judges, inter alia, ordered the parties to the referenced proceedings¹ to notify the Judges if the parties reach any accommodation that obviates the need for further participation in the proceeding. On January 7, 2022, all of the parties to the cable royalty distribution proceeding filed a Joint Notice of Settlement and Motion for Final Distribution Regarding Royalty Claims of National Public Radio (the “Joint Notice”). The Joint Notice notified the Judges that all of the parties to the cable royalty distribution proceeding have reached agreement with respect to the royalty share for NPR in that proceeding and included a motion by all of the parties to the proceeding that NPR should receive the agreed-upon share as a final distribution pursuant to Section 802(b)(3)(A) of the Copyright Act.

¹ NPR is a party to the cable royalty distribution proceeding, Docket No. 16-CRB-0009-CD (2014-2017) but is not a party to the satellite royalty distribution proceeding, Docket No. 16-0010-CD (2014-2017).

Subject to the Judges' consideration of and action on the pending Joint Notice, NPR hereby notifies the Judges that it believes that this settlement obviates the need for NPR's further participation in the cable royalty distribution proceeding.
