RESPONSE OF  
MOTION PICTURE ASSOCIATION OF AMERICA, INC.,  
ITS LISTED MEMBER COMPANIES AND  
OTHER PROGRAM SUPPLIERS

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The Motion Picture Association of America, Inc. (MPAA),  
its listed member companies and other program suppliers<sup>1/</sup>  
submit the following in response to the Order of the Tri-  
bunal, 47 F.R. 57748, December 28, 1982, directing each  
claimant category to notify the Tribunal of any voluntary  
agreements for distribution of royalty fees among the  
claimants within a category; of their intention to present  
evidence in Phase II of this proceeding; and the Phase II  
issues to be decided.

Voluntary agreements for distribution of royalty fees  
have been entered into by 57 program suppliers.<sup>2/</sup>

The issue presented is the entitlements of the group of  
57 claimants who have proceeded under the provisions of Sec-  
tion 111(d)(5)(A) and have designated a common agent to  
receive payment on their behalf; and of other claimants  
who have elected to prosecute their respective claims indi-  
vidually.

Evidence will be presented with respect to the allocable share of the 57 program suppliers and other eligible individual claimants of the allocation made by the Tribunal.




