

ORDER

On October 3, 1985, the Tribunal concluded its consolidated hearing of the 1982 (remand) and the 1983 jukebox distribution proceedings. The record remained open, however, pending the submission of certain documents from the parties. The Tribunal has now received the following documents:

1. Affidavit of Dwight S. Young
2. ACEMLA's list of national and international publishing entities with whom they have contracts.
3. Information concerning ASCAP's survey of radio stations with Spanish-language formats during 1982 and 1983.
4. Data underlying the survey of 76 jukeboxes conducted by ASCAP.
5. List of songs referenced in A/B/S Exh. 9 which also appear on the Music Claimants' list of most-performed Spanish-language songs in 1982 and 1983.
6. Stipulation reached by ASCAP, BMI, SESAC, Inc. and ACEMLA regarding the claims of Italian Book Corp.
7. Two translations of ACEMLA's Spanish-language contracts, one performed by ACEMLA, the other performed by the Music Claimants.

Accordingly, the record of the 1982 (remand) and the 1983 jukebox distribution proceeding is hereby closed.
