Stipulation

0.77

It is hereby stipulated among the Motion Picture Association of America, Inc., the National Association of Broadcasters, Inc., and Turner Broadcasting Systems, Inc. that if Robert W. Ross were called to testify in the 1983 Cable Royalty Distribution Proceeding, he would testify to the following:

- That he is Vice-President and General Counsel of Turner Broadcasting System, Inc. (TBS, Inc.).
- 2. That his testimony is based upon information provided to him by the employees of TBS, Inc. and its subsidiaries and TBS, Inc.'s files and records.
- 3. During 1983 two separate wrestling programs entitled "World Championship Wrestling" were either broadcast on WTBS or syndicated to U.S. television stations. One of the two programs was broadcast only on WTBS during 1983 in episodes generally two hours in length. This program consisted of staged wrestling events, interviews and wrestling promotion taped live on Saturday mornings at WTBS' studios in Atlanta which were broadcast on a delayed basis on WTBS later on the same day it was taped. Upon information and belief a limited number of programs produced in 1983 may have contained footage of materials which were taped outside of the WTBS studios and which were produced by Georgia Championship

- Wrestling, Inc. and supplied to TBS, Inc. for inclusion in the "World Championship Wrestling" program that was broadcast on WTBS. The number of shows which contained such tapes, if any, were de minimus.
- In addition, Turner Program Services, Inc. ("TPS"), a sub-4. sidiary of TBS, Inc., syndicated during 1983 to U.S. TV stations another wrestling program also entitled "World Championship Wrestling." This program was not broadcast on WTBS during 1983. This one-hour program consisted of edited versions of the same wrestling matches used in "World Championship Wrestling" which appeared on WTBS. matches were selected from a library of previously produced matches and were edited by TPS to conform to time and artistic requirements of the syndicated program. All rights in the copyright and royalties under section 111 in this program are the property of TBS, Inc. pursuant to its contract with Georgia Championship Wrestling, Inc. The syndicated version of "World Championship Wrestling" was offered for syndication and was syndicated for broadcast in 1983 to three U.S. commercial TV stations. Although some matches appearing in the WTBS program of the same name were included as part of the syndicated versions, other elements of the syndicated version were not previously broadcast on WTBS during 1983.
- 5. The 1983 edition of Broadcasting Information Bureau <u>Series</u>,

 Serials <u>Packages</u> ("BIB Book") lists "World Championship

Wrestling" as a program available for syndication and lists
Turner Program Services as having "World Championship
Wrestling" as one of its syndicated programs. A copy of
the page related to "World Championship Wrestling" from
the BIB Book is attached to this Stipulation.

- 6. The 1980 edition of the BIB Book does not contain any listing for Georgia Championship Wrestling or for Turner Program
 Services.
- 7. A program entitled "The Best of World Championship Wrestling" was broadcast only on WTBS during 1983 and appeared during the same time periods as the program called "Sunday Sports" in Tribunal Exhibit No. 2. The "Best of World Championship Wrestling" is a one-hour, weekly program consisting of edited versions of taped wrestling matches previously included in WTBS' "World Championship Wrestling" program described in paragraph 3, and of new interviews and promotional materials including new introductory material. The editing was done by TBS employees using the station's tape library of previously broadcast Saturday matches.
- 8. Prior to 1983, the two wrestling programs broadcast by WTBS were exhibited under the name "Georgia Championship Wrestling" and "Best of Georgia Championship Wrestling." On information and belief those programs are identified in NAB exhibit 28R as "GA. CHAM SPTS" and "SUN SPTS." The titles were changed in October of 1982 to "World Championship Wrestling" and "Best of World Championship Wrestling."
- 9. The "World Championship Wrestling" and the "Best of World

Championship Wrestling" programs broadcast only on WTBS were produced during 1983 under a contract with TBS, Inc. by Georgia Championship Wrestling, Inc. Georgia Championship Wrestling, Inc. acknowledged TBS, Inc. as the sole and exclusive owner of all rights to the copyright in these wrestling programs and all copyright royalties attributable to the distant cable carriage of the programs under section 111 of the Copyright Act. The two wrestling programs as described in paragraphs 3 and 7 were broadcast only on WTBS during 1983 and were not syndicated or offered for syndication to any other U.S. TV stations. The "World Championship Wrestling" program described in paragraph 4 syndicated by TBS was different from both of these programs.

10. Georgia Championship Wrestling, Inc. had the right to produce and distribute, and upon information and belief, did produce and distribute during 1983 another one-hour program of wrestling matches entitled "Georgia Championship Wrestling." This program included excerpts of matches originally produced for inclusion in the "World Championship Wrestling" programs described in paragraph 3 which were previously broadcast on WTBS and which were chosen to conform to time, artistic, and promotional requirements of Georgia Championship Wrestling, Inc. "Georgia Championship Wrestling" also contained new interviews and wrestling promotional material. Upon information and belief, Georgia Championship Wrestling typically distributed this program to stations in markets where it promoted live wrestling events that

featured performers appearing in the wrestling programs. All rights in the copyright and royalties under section lll for this program are the property of TBS, Inc. pursuant to the contract with Georgia Championship Wrestling, Inc. The program "Georgia Championship Wrestling" syndicated by Georgia Championship Wrestling, Inc. was not broadcast on WTBS during 1983. Upon information and belief the program appeared in syndication during 1983 on seven U.S. commercial TV stations.

11. The following programs, among others, were broadcast during 1983 on WTBS, and except as described in paragraph 15 were not syndicated to any other TV station:

"Portrait of America Series" (Oregon, Virginia, Nevada, Texas)
"Good News"

"Nice People"

"In Defense of Freedom"

"24 Hours Daytona"

"Atlanta 500"

"Richmond 400"

"Riverside 500"

- 12. "Good News" and "Nice People" were produced by TBS Productions, the TBS, Inc. in-house production company. Attempts were made to syndicate these programs, but they were not syndicated in 1983.
- 13. "In Defense of Freedom" was a five-part series on the U.S.

 Armed Forces produced by Science Communications, Inc.

 ("SCI") for TBS, Inc. and TBS had the exclusive right to broadcast this program during 1983. So far as TBS, Inc.

 knows, this program did not appear in syndication in 1983 and upon information and belief it did appear in syndication

subsequent to 1983. TPS, pursuant to its contract with SCI, has the right to claim royalties for the distant transmission by cable systems of this program under section 111.

- 14. "24 Hours Daytona," "Atlanta Journal 500," "Richmond 400," and "Riverside 500" were produced exclusively for TPS by Motorweek Productions ("Motorweek"). No attempts were made to syndicate these programs and these programs appeared exclusively on WTBS during 1983. TPS, pursuant to its contract with Motorweek, has the right to claim royalties for the distant transmission by cable systems of these programs under section 111.
- 15. The "Portrait of America Series," including Portrait of Oregon, Portrait of Nevada, Portrait of Texas, and Portrait of Virginia, were produced by TBS Productions and the copyright in these programs is held by TPS. These programs were never offered in syndication for exhibition in 1983. A contract was signed in 1983 for exhibition in 1984, but the contract was rescinded. The attached listing from the BIB Book lists "Portrait of America" as available for syndication in 1983.
- 16. That he has had no explicit knowledge of the NAB's definition of "local" programming.
- 17. That he has had no explicit knowledge of the definition of "local" programming or "minor sports" programming as used in the Nielsen special study categorization of programming.

18. The attachment of the aforementioned referenced pages from the BIB books are solely for purposes of clarification of the record with regard to the listing of these programs by sources other than TBS, Inc. Other than the syndicated version of "World Championship Wrestling" and "Portrait of America" listed in paragraphs 5 and 15, the other programs listed in paragraph 11 were not listed in the 1983 BIB book as being available for syndication.

The foregoing stipulation is accepted and agreed to this 18th day of December, 1985.


