REPLY COMMENTS OF CABLE  
REPRESENTATIVES AND COPYRIGHT OWNERS

Pursuant to the Tribunal's notice of March 19, 1985 (50 Fed. Reg. 10989), the National Cable Television Association and Community Antenna Television Association ("Cable Representatives") and the Motion Picture Association of America, Inc., Major League Baseball, National Basketball Association, North American Soccer League, National Hockey League, National Collegiate Athletic Association, American Society of Composers, Authors and Publishers, Broadcast Music, Inc., SESAC, Inc. and National Association of Broadcasters ("Copyright Owners") hereby file their reply comments urging immediate Tribunal approval of the Settlement Agreement resolving this matter.

National Public Radio was the only other party to submit comments in this proceeding, and those comments support approval of the settlement. The absence of any opposition to the settlement is yet another reason for immediate approval and effectiveness of the proposed regulations.

For the reasons stated in our earlier papers and in this reply, Cable Representatives and Copyright Owners submit that the Tribunal should allow the adjusted rates and limitations in the Settlement Agreement (as modified) to become effective immediately.
