REQUEST FOR AN EXTENSION


The Joint Sports Claimants hereby request that the Tribunal grant a two-day extension of time from July 7, 1980 to July 9, 1980 for the filing of proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law in this proceeding. We have notified counsel for MPAA, NAB and PBS of our request, and they have authorized us to represent to the Tribunal that they do not oppose such an extension. In the interest of fairness, of course, the extension would apply to all of the parties to the proceeding.

This request is necessitated by factors related to the mechanics of producing the document by Monday, July 7th. The law firm of Arnold & Porter, counsel for the Joint Sports Claimants, is moving to a new office building during

the three-day July 4th weekend. The disruption caused by this move is significantly greater than we had anticipated. Because of the move and the holiday, our access to office space, files, supplies, typewriters, word processing equipment, duplicating machines, and other necessary resources is limited. Since we will be in place in the new offices on Monday, we are confident that we will be able to produce and file our document by the end of the day on Wednesday, July 9th; no further requests for extension of time will be made.

For the foregoing reasons, the Joint Sports Claimants request the Tribunal to grant an extension of time to all of the parties until July 9, 1980, to file proposed findings of fact and conclusions of law. If the Tribunal grants this request, the Joint Sports Claimants will notify immediately the parties on the attached list.


