Dear Ms. Burg:

This letter is submitted on behalf of the Motion Picture Association of America, Inc., its member companies and other companies engaged in the production and distribution of programming exhibited by television broadcast stations ("Program Syndicators"). 1/

With the exception of ITC Entertainment Inc. each of the companies listed in Attachment A has authorized the undersigned to advise the Tribunal that it has agreed to a formula for the distribution of the amount of cable royalty fees allocated to program syndicators, together with the respective share to be distributed to its company. In addition, the following companies have joined in the aforesaid agreement on the formula for distribution and their respective shares of the fund: Group W Productions, Inc.; D. L. Taffner Ltd.; Spanish International Network, Inc.; TCI Programs Inc.; Metromedia Producers Corp.; Jack Barry Productions; Barry and Enright Productions Inc.; Claster Productions; MLB Productions; Worldvision Enterprises, Inc.; and King Features Syndicate Inc.
