
Dear Madam Chairman

This letter is written on behalf of Grinnell Communications Corporation, licensee of television station WDTN, Dayton, Ohio. Grinnell Communications is the owner and producer of syndicated programs which were described in a preliminary claim for cable copyright royalty filed July 27, 1978 (Certificate of Mailing filed August 1, 1978).

Pursuant to the notice of the Copyright Royalty Tribunal dated July 25, 1980 (45 F.R. 50621, July 30, 1980), the Tribunal is advised that Grinnell Communications Corporation will not join the voluntary arrangement for distribution of royalty fees among the members of the joint claim of the Motion Picture Association of America, et al. Grinnell Communications will present testimony during Phase II and its entitlement justification will be presented by Roger W. Wagner of bi Associates Inc. of Kensington, Maryland.
