ORDER CONSOLIDATING PROCEEDINGS

The Copyright Royalty Judges (Judges) have in the past commenced proceedings to distribute royalty funds deposited pursuant to chapter 10, title 17, United States Code, for license years 2007 through 2011. For some years, the Judges have approved partial distributions to copyright owners. The Judges have ascertained that funds deposited in the Sound Recordings funds remain undistributed for the subject years. To accomplish fair and final distribution of all remaining funds, the Judges hereby **CONSOLIDATE** the captioned proceedings insofar as they concern Sound Recording royalties in any of the subfunds of the Sound Recording fund; *to wit*, Copyright Owners, Featured Recording Artists, and Nonfeatured Recording Artists, the last of which is further subdivided into royalty pools for Nonfeatured Musicians and Nonfeatured Vocalists.

Any entity filing pleadings or other papers relating to the Sound Recording fund shall make only one filing using the following CONSOLIDATED CAPTION:

In each document, the filing party must identify *with specificity* the subfund(s) that is/are the subject of the filing and the year(s) at issue.

The Judges anticipate publication of a solicitation of Petitions to Participate in the distributions they will make in this Consolidated Proceeding. Any entity wishing to participate in distribution of funds remaining in any Sound Recording subfunds for the years 2007 through and including 2011 MUST FILE a Petition to Participate in this Consolidated Proceeding on or before the date stated in the Federal Register publication, even if that entity has filed previously a Petition to Participate in any of the constituent proceedings being now CONSOLIDATED.

All entities must file papers and other pleadings using the CRB electronic filing system (ECRB) at <https://app.crb.gov/>. The electronic filing system will not accept filings using any of the captions now consolidated. The Judges will not accept filings made in paper form, except when those filings meet the requirements of 37 CFR 350.5(j).
