SIRIUS SATELLITE RADIO INC.'S PETITION TO PARTICIPATE

Pursuant to 17 U.S.C. § 803(b)(1)(B) and 71 Fed. Reg. 1455 (Jan. 9, 2006), Sirius Satellite Radio Inc. ("Sirius") hereby petitions to participate in the above-captioned proceeding to adjust the rates and terms for the statutory licenses set forth in 17 U.S.C. §§ 112 and 114 for the activities of preexisting subscription services ("PSS") and preexisting satellite digital audio radio services ("SDARS").


Sirius has a significant interest in the above-captioned proceeding for two reasons. First, Sirius' satellite digital audio radio service is one of the two preexisting SDARS identified by the Copyright Act. Second, the audio service provided by Sirius in connection with the DISH Network satellite television service is a PSS under 17 U.S.C. § 114(d)(2). Thus, the Sirius satellite digital audio radio service and DISH service will be subject to the rates and terms established for preexisting SDARSs and PSSs in the above-captioned proceeding.

Sirius intends fully to participate in the above-captioned proceeding.
