**Distribution of 2014 Digital Audio  
Recording Royalty Funds**

**DISTRIBUTION ORDER**

On February 4, 2015, the Copyright Royalty Board (“CRB”) received two letters from Mr. Dennis Dreith, Independent Administrator of the Nonfeatured Musicians Subfund and the Nonfeatured Vocalists Subfund of the DART Sound Recordings Fund, informing the CRB of his appointment to manage and ultimately distribute the 2014 royalties allocated to these Subfunds.<sup>1</sup> See 17 U.S.C. § 1006(b)(1) and 37 C.F.R. § 360.23. Consequently, Mr. Dreith has requested transfer of the 2014 royalties allocated to the Nonfeatured Musicians Subfund and the Nonfeatured Vocalists Subfund.

Accordingly, the Copyright Royalty Judges **ORDER** that the 2014 royalties in the Nonfeatured Musicians Subfund and the Nonfeatured Vocalists Subfund of the 2014 DART Sound Recordings Fund **BE DISTRIBUTED** to Mr. Dennis Dreith, on or after **April 9, 2015**, provided that the Copyright Office receives all pertinent information to effect the transfer of funds no later than seven business days before the distribution date.
