**ORDER REJECTING PETITION TO PARTICIPATE OF DAVID POWELL**

On May 17, 2016, the Copyright Royalty Judges (Judges) received a “Pro Se Petition to Participate & Motion Objection” from David Powell.


The filing is problematic for at least two reasons:

1. It was filed over a year past the deadline for filing Petitions to Participate in this proceeding, *see* 80 Fed. Reg. 15632, contained no reason for the late filing, and was not accompanied by the filing fee.
2. The filing does not refer to the subject matter of this proceeding (DART distribution), but instead refers to cable rates and satellite distribution matters.

Mr. Powell’s Petition to Participate is too late and does not state that he has any interest in this proceeding. *See* 37 C.F.R. 351.1(b)(4).

The Judges therefore **REJECT** his Petition to Participate. Mr. Powell is **PROHIBITED** from filing further papers in this proceeding.
