

**ORDER GRANTING EXTENSION OF TIME
FOR FILING WRITTEN DIRECT STATEMENTS**

On December 1, 2014, the Copyright Royalty Judges (Judges) received a *Joint Motion for Extension of Time for Filing Written Direct Statements* (Joint Motion) filed by SoundExchange, Inc. and Sirius XM Radio Inc. (Parties). In the Joint Motion, the Parties assert that they are the only remaining participants in the captioned proceeding. The Parties state that they have reached an agreement in principle to settle the proceeding, but that it is unlikely that they will “be able to finalize language embodying their settlement and secure final approvals from all necessary persons” by December 1, 2014, the deadline for submitting written direct statements. *Joint Motion* at 1. Accordingly, the Parties request that the Judges extend the deadline for filing written direct statements to December 12, 2014. The Parties represent that they will submit a settlement pursuant to 17 U.S.C. § 801(b)(7)(A) and 37 C.F.R. § 351.2(b)(2) by that date.

In light of the Parties’ good faith efforts to reach a settlement in this proceeding, the Judges hereby **GRANT** the requested extension of time.
