On October 25, 1985, the Joint Sports Claimants (JSC) and Program Suppliers (MPAA) submitted a joint motion for final distribution of all royalties remaining in the 1979, 1980, 1981 and 1982 cable royalty fee funds on or before November 21, 1985. On October 29, 1985, National Public Radio filed in support of the JSC and MPAA motion.

I vote that the Tribunal deny the motion and move that the Tribunal publish in the Federal Register, no later than November 17, 1985, that all the remaining royalties in the 1979, 1980, 1981, and 1982 cable royalty funds be distributed on December 13, 1985 in the same final percentage awards as identified in the Tribunal's order published on March 6, 1985 (50 FR 9112). *ER*

In my opinion, a final distribution on December 13, 1985 will eliminate any possibility of controversy by any party since the final date for appeals will have ended.
