

MOTION FOR FINAL DISTRIBUTION

Program Suppliers hereby move the Tribunal for final distribution of the 1979, 1980, 1981, and 1982 royalty funds. On February 24, 1986, the Supreme Court denied the petition for writ of certiorari filed in CBN v. CRT, No. 85-926. This denial means that the Tribunal's decisions in those proceedings are final and no longer subject to controversy.

Because none of the amounts in these funds is subject to controversy, a final distribution of all funds is properly made at this time. Program Suppliers have set forth in the attached schedule the amounts remaining in each fund, and the percentage awards and resulting dollar amounts to be distributed to each claimant. These figures were calculated based on the size of the funds as of January 31, 1986, so some minor adjustment will be necessary to account for interest and expenses since that time.
