- A. This claim is being presented on behalf of Grinnell Communications Corporation.

- C. The copyright works whose secondary transmission provides the basis for the claim are as follows:

The above shows represent 1198 (14.9%) broadcast hours of 8,058 hours of broadcasting in 1978. These programs are produced locally or are cooperatively produced with production costs and all rights shared by this station. In addition to those programs mentioned above the company syndicates two locally produced nationally distributed programs. They are as follows: The Butcher and House Call. During 1978 according to license agreements these programs were broadcast a minimum of 244 hours. Since the broadcast of these shows is unlimited during the license period it is not possible to calculate the actual broadcast time but our estimates are conservative.

- D. Secondary transmission of the Channel 2 signal by the local cable systems carrying our programming on exclusive basis amounts to 8,058 hours of broadcasting for the year 1978 for each system. These exclusively (non duplication) cable systems are as follows:

- E. Compared to nationwide 1978 television revenues of \$4,647,600,000 published 4/9/79 in Television Radio Age this stations 1978 revenue was \$7,921,584 or .17% of the US revenue. Therefore this station should be entitled to at least .17% of the 12,000,000 copyright pool of funds or \$20,400. Additional funds should also be paid for nationally syndicated programs which are distributed in 187 markets and 139 markets for The Butcher and Housecall respectively.
