  - c. Community Affairs:
    - (1) Aroun' Town - Monday-Friday, 12-1230P,  
Women's feature and discussion type program.
    - (2) Inquiry - Sunday, 1015-1030P, a public affairs  
discussion show.
3. Percentage of Collected Royalties to which Station  
is Entitled: .0116 or 16 hundredths of 1% (16% of 1%) or \$1392.
4. Justification:
  - a. Panama City ADI represents .07 of the total tele-  
vision households in the United States.

b. Panama City is a two station market; therefore, station is entitled to .035% of the funds times cable household penetration in the total survey area, which is 33% equals .0116%.

c. .0116% times \$12,000,000 equals \$1392.
