
Re: Claim of Westinghouse Broadcasting Company, Inc.

Dear Chairman Burg:

This is in reference to the Tribunal's pending proceedings concerning the distribution of copyright royalty fees for the year 1978. We wish to notify the Tribunal that it is not our intention at this time to participate actively in the upcoming hearings which have been scheduled by the Tribunal. In view of the essential structure of these hearings to determine basic fee allocation principles among the major claimant groups, it does not appear necessary or beneficial from the standpoint of the Tribunal to burden the hearing process with individual claims already on file with the Tribunal and which will be considered in the larger context of the major claimant groups.

In advising the Tribunal of this, however, it should be stressed that it is not our intention to waive or withdraw our pending claim which is now on file. Should the Tribunal feel that any additional information and/or other action on our part is necessary to maintain the status of our claim in good standing, please advise and we will undertake to cooperate with the Tribunal.
