**NOTICE OF FILING OF PUBLIC VERSION OF THE WRITTEN DIRECT  
STATEMENT OF THE NATIONAL RELIGIOUS BROADCASTERS MUSIC  
LICENSE COMMITTEE, INCLUDING EDUCATIONAL MEDIA FOUNDATION**

Pursuant to Order 9 Protective Order (“Protective Order”), issued on September 6, 2024 by the Copyright Royalty Judges, the National Religious Broadcasters Music License Committee, including Educational Media Foundation (“NRBMLC”), has filed on September 17, 2024 public versions of Volumes 2, 3, and 4 of its Written Direct Statement. Volume 1 did not contain Restricted material subject to the Protective Order.

Please note that when the Restricted version of the September 13, 2024 Written Direct Testimony of Patrick J. Holder, Ph.D., included in Volume 2 of the NRBMLC’s Written Direct Statement, was converted from a Word file to a PDF file, there appears to have been a technical anomaly introduced in the PDF conversion process that caused many of the headings to overwrite text and to appear in a smaller font size. In consultation with Ms. Kimberly Whittle of the Copyright Royalty Board, and to ensure the prompt availability of a legible public version of Dr. Holder’s testimony, the NRBMLC reconverted the Word file of his testimony to enable the headings to display properly and has submitted a public version of Volume 2 that includes this reconverted file. No additional changes have been made other than the redactions and markings necessary to create a public version of the filing pursuant to the Protective Order. The

NRBMLC intends to seek leave to submit a corrected version of Dr. Holder's Restricted Written Direct Testimony at a later time and apologizes for this technical issue.
