

NOTICE TO ALL PARTIES IN ALL PENDING PROCEEDINGS

ORDER

Upon review of pleadings filed in pending proceedings, the Copyright Royalty Judges cannot determine that the requirements of 37 CFR Sec. 350.2 Representation have been satisfied by all parties. This lack of clarity suggests that some modification of the section on representation may need amendment to add some provisions of Fed. R. Civ. P. 11. The Copyright Royalty Judges will review 37 CFR Sections 350.2 and 350.4(e) for needed amendments. In the meantime, all parties, appearing *pro se* or by counsel, are directed to file a pleading in each proceeding in which they have appeared demonstrating how they comply with 37 CFR Sec. 350.2 Representation. This pleading is to be filed by February 17, 2006.
