**NOTICE OF PARTIAL WITHDRAWAL OF SOUNDEXCHANGE’S MOTION TO
COMPEL DISCOVERY FROM THE NATIONAL RELIGIOUS BROADCASTERS
MUSIC LICENSE COMMITTEE AND EDUCATIONAL MEDIA FOUNDATION**

On November 12, 2024, SoundExchange, Inc. (“SoundExchange”) filed a motion (Dkt. No. 43827, the “Motion”) seeking to compel the production of discovery from the National Religious Broadcasters Music License Committee (“NRBMLC”) and Educational Media Foundation (“EMF”).

Following the filing of the motion, SoundExchange and the NRBMLC had an additional meet-and-confer call related to certain of the document requests identified in the Motion, and were able to narrow the issues in dispute. As such, SoundExchange hereby withdraws the motion with respect to Requests No. 24, 34, 35, 39, 72, 73, and 77.
