CLAIMANTS' JOINT MOTION FOR AN EXTENSION OF TIME

The American Society of Composers, Authors, and Publishers, Broadcast Music, Inc., Canadian Claimants Group, Commercial Television Claimants, Joint Sports Claimants, National Public Radio, Public Television Claimants, and SESAC Performing Rights, LLC (collectively, “the Claimants”) hereby respectfully submit the following Joint Motion for an Extension of Time.

On December 18, 2024, the Copyright Royalty Judges (“Judges”) entered Order 2 Addressing Overpayment And Surplus Issues (eCRB No. 44285) and on December 19, 2024, the Judges entered Order 3 Clarifying Order 2 Addressing Overpayment And Surplus Issues (eCRB No. 44847). Order 2 and Order 3 ordered the Claimants to provide various information regarding past partial royalty payments received and repayment agreements. The joint notice of service of Order 2 and Order 3 was filed on December 23, 2024 (eCRB No. 44862).

The Claimants respectfully and jointly request two additional weeks to respond to Orders 2 and 3 regarding past partial royalty payments and repayment agreements. The requested extension would extend the deadline from January 8, 2025 to January 22, 2025. The Claimants are diligently working to complete the necessary review and information collection, but the Claimants need additional time to respond. The Claimants' request is both modest and reasonable given the holiday season, unexpected nature of the request, and because the request seeks information dating back to the royalty year 1999, some of which exists only in paper form. Therefore, the Claimants respectfully and jointly seek an extension to January 22, 2025, to respond to Orders 2 and 3.
