ORDER DENYING WRITE 4 U PUBLISHING'S REQUEST FOR THE  
REMAINING 2% OF THE 2010 FEATURED ARTIST  
AND SOUND RECORDINGS FUNDS

On December 23, 2011, the Copyright Royalty Judges received a "Motion for Distribution of the Remaining 2% of the 2010 Featured Artist and Sound Recordings Funds" from Treasa Fennie ("dba") Write 4 U Publishing ("Motion"). The Motion contained neither a representation that Ms. Fennie is an attorney authorized to represent another party before the Judges nor proof that Ms. Fennie served other parties in this matter. Both are required by the Judges' rules of procedure. *See* 37 CFR § 350.2 (all parties other than individual parties "must be represented by an attorney") and § 350.4(g) (a copy of all filings shall be served on all parties and proof of service shall accompany the filing).

Therefore, the Motion is **DENIED** without prejudice.
