2018-2021 SATELLITE ROYALTY FUNDS

National Women’s Soccer League, LLC (“NWSL”), hereby submits its Notice of Controversy in response to the Copyright Royalty Judges’ (“Judges”) Order of Consolidation, Notice of Participants, and Order Setting Case Schedule, dated October 30, 2024, in the above-noted, consolidated docket.

NWSL, as represented by undersigned counsel, has claims to royalties awarded for live professional team sports broadcasts related to satellite funds for 2021. With respect to that year, NWSL is aware of Distribution Phase controversies in the Joint Sports Claimants’ (“JSC”) category among NWSL and other members of that group.

At this time, negotiations to resolve the allocation of funds within the JSC category have not settled. If Distribution Phase hearings are held, then NWSL intends to participate.
