**INDEPENDENT PRODUCERS GROUP'S
MOTION FOR LATE-FILED ACCEPTANCE OF
COMMENTS TO PARTIAL DISTRIBUTION OF FUNDS**

Worldwide Subsidy Group LLC (a Texas limited liability company) dba Independent Producers Group ("IPG"), hereby moves for the Copyright Royalty Board's late-filed acceptance of IPG's Comments in response to the Notice Requesting Comments to Partial Distribution of 2009 Funds, published September 6, 2011 by the Library of Congress, 76 Fed. Reg. 55122.

IPG's comments were due on October 6, 2011. In all candor, IPG misunderstood the notice, and believed that it only solicited comments on the proposed distribution of 50% of the cable royalty funds. IPG does not challenge such distribution. However, until seeing comments submitted by other parties, IPG did not appreciate that the notice also requested information as to whether any disputes exist in the Phase II categories.

In light of the early juncture of the 2009 proceedings, and the fact that no Phase I proceedings have yet to be resolved, IPG informing the Copyright Royalty Board of its Phase II claims at this time (i.e., one business day late) is of no prejudice to any other
