Dear Mr. Hochberg:

The Copyright Royalty Board received the 2007 Joint Cable claim you filed on behalf of National Football League, National Hockey League (nongame and game), and National Basketball Association (Nongame). We also received your 2007 Single Cable claims that you filed on behalf of Guthy-Renker, Nascar Media Group, WNBA Enterprises (game), National Basketball Association (game) and NFL Films. A properly filed claim, in addition to being timely filed, must contain all the elements outlined in the Code of Federal Regulations. 37 C.F.R. § 360.3.

After reviewing the claim for compliance with the applicable regulations, the Board is returning your claim because it was not filed using the required form. *See* 37 C.F.R. § 360.3(a)(1) (“Each [cable] claim . . . shall be furnished on a form prescribed by the Copyright Royalty Board . . .”).

In order for your claim to be accepted as valid, you must amend it by filling out the enclosed amendment form. The completed form and the originals must be returned to the Board on or before **Thursday, December 4, 2008**.

You may submit your amended claim by sending the requested completed amendment form in PDF format to [cableclaims@loc.gov](mailto:cableclaims@loc.gov). Or, you may submit the requested amendment form in one of the following ways: If sent via the U.S. Postal Service, send the information via certified mail, return receipt requested, to the following address: Copyright Royalty Board, P.O. Box 70977, Southwest Station, Washington, D.C. 20024; if hand delivered by a private party, the information should be brought to Room LM-401 of the James Madison Memorial Building between 8:30 a.m. and 5 p.m., and the envelope should be addressed as follows: Copyright Royalty Board, Library of Congress, James Madison Memorial Building, Room LM-401, 101 Independence Avenue, S.E., Washington, D.C. 20559-6000; if delivered by a commercial courier, the information must be delivered to the Congressional Courier Acceptance Site located at 2<sup>nd</sup>


and D Streets, N.E., between 8:30 a.m. and 4 p.m. The envelope should be addressed as follows: Copyright Royalty Board, Room LM-401, James Madison Memorial Building, 101 Independence Avenue, S.E., Washington, D.C.

Please note that you **cannot** use corporate couriers such as Federal Express or United Parcel Service to submit the requested information. 37 C.F.R. § 360.4(a)(5).

Regardless of which method you select—either via e-mail or as outlined immediately above—the amended form and the originals **must** be received by the Board on or before **Thursday, December 4, 2008**; otherwise, the claim may be dismissed for noncompliance with the filing regulations.
