Dear Sirs:

In July 2008 and 2009, our company, MG/Perin, Inc., filed claims for 2007 and 2008 cable and satellite statutory license royalties (copies attached).


In each case we filed joint claims on behalf of (1) ourselves for certain works MG/Perin claims; and on behalf of (2) another program owner with whom we co-own a separate show.

MPAA has advised us that CRB regulations require clarification that royalties can be paid for the MG/Perin programs because we referred to MG/Perin as "filer" rather than "copyright owner" in our claims.

In our view, given that we filed a joint claim but with only one owner listed in the copyright owner section of the form, it should be apparent that the other owner is MG/Perin whose full information is listed in the claim. Thus, we believe we have supplied the required information, albeit perhaps in the wrong location, for including MG/Perin as one of the two copyright owners covered by the joint claim.

MG/Perin would appreciate confirmation that our 2007 and 2008 joint cable and satellite claims, as filed, provide sufficient information to show that MG/Perin is one of two owners covered by the claims and is entitled to participate in the allocation of royalties for those years for the works we claim on our own behalf.
