
PETITION TO PARTICIPATE

Pursuant to Section 804(b)(3)(A) of the Copyright Act, Title 17, Section 351.1 (b) of the Copyright Royalty Judges Rules and Procedures, (37 CFR 351.1(b)), and Federal Register No. 74, No. 2, (Monday, January 5, 2009), Access2ip herein files with the Library of Congress, Copyright Office, this petition stating the entity's intention to participate in the above-captioned proceeding before the Copyright Royalty Judges to establish reasonable rates and terms for compulsory licenses in connection with digital sound recording performances (17 U.S.C. § 114(f)(2)) and related ephemeral reproduction rights (17 U.S.C. § 112(e)) by means of "eligible nonsubscription transmissions" and/or transmissions by a "new subscription service" for the period beginning January 1, 2011, and ending on December 31, 2015.

As an organization of webcasters and their service providers, Access2ip has significant interests in the subject matter of this proceeding because many of its members utilize and perform sound recordings under the above referenced licenses and therefore will be subject to the rates and terms established in this proceeding. As such, petitioner intends to fully participate in this proceeding.
