**JOINT MOTION OF THE ALLOCATION PHASE PARTIES TO ADOPT PROPOSED
ORDERS REGARDING HEARING PROCEDURES**

On February 18, 2026, the Copyright Royalty Judges (“Judges”) issued *Order 10 Regarding Further Proceedings* (“Order 10”), which directed the Canadian Claimants Group (“CCG”), Commercial Television Claimants (“CTV”), Joint Sports Claimants (“JSC”), Program Suppliers, Public Television Claimants (“PTV”), and Settling Devotional Claimants (“SDC”) (collectively the “Allocation Phase Parties”) to confer with Copyright Royalty Board Staff regarding the logistical and scheduling issues associated with scheduling a hearing for the Allocation Phase of this proceeding. Order 10 at 1-2.

The Allocation Phase Parties met with Copyright Royalty Board Staff as directed and received their comments and feedback on two proposed orders which are being filed concurrently with this joint motion:

- (1) [Proposed] Order On Detailed Hearing Protocols And Procedures For Virtual Hearing
- (2) [Proposed] Order On Hearing Schedule And Related Prehearing Matters
