(1) All station produced programming (including newscasts, public affairs,  
children's and sports programming) broadcast by WDIV, including but not  
limited to:

- (a) Newsbeat at 5
- (b) Newsbeat at 6
- (c) News 4 Nightbeat

(2) The station's entire broadcast as a compilation.

(3) Syndicated programs for which WDIV is the copyright holder of exclusive  
exhibition rights against other broadcast stations carried by a cable system  
in the WDIV market area as a distant retransmission, including but not  
limited to:

- (a) Various off-network, made for TV, syndicated programs by film and tape.
- (b) Sports events broadcast by WDIV.

(4) Programs produced by Post-Newsweek Stations, Inc. including documentaries.


